PROCEEDINGS OF THE POLICE JURY

STATE OF LOUISIANA, PARISH OF TENNASS.

St. Joseph, La., December 2nd, 1912.

Be it known that on this 2nd day of December, 1912, it being the first Monday in said month, and the day for the regular meeting of the Police Jury of the Parish of Tensas, Louisiana, said Board met at the Court House at St. Joseph, La. There were present:

Hon. Frank H. Curry, President, and Messrs. Jno. D. Fultz, F. L. Guthrie and Louis T. Hunter, members.

The Committee appointed to examine the books of the Parish Treasurer, reported that said examination had been made and said books found correct.

On motion, duly seconded, the following ordinance was adopted:

Be it ordained by the Police Jury of the Parish of Tensas, That the Parish License for the sale, at retail, of distilled or alcoholic and malt liquors in the Parish of Tensas, for the year 1913, be and the same is hereby fixed at Fifteen Hundred Dollars, the same to be due and collectible on January 1st, 1913, and to expire December 31st, 1913.

Be it further ordained, That the six months license to be issued during the latter half of the year 1913 be and the same is hereby fixed at One Hundred per centum of the annual license.

On motion, duly seconded, the following ordinance was adopted:

Be it ordained by the Police Jury of the Parish of Tensas, That Parish license, for the sale, at retail, of pistols, pistol cartridges, blank pistols and blank pistol cartridges for the year 1913, be and the same is hereby fixed at an amount equal to One Hundred per centum of the license imposed by the State of Louisiana for the same.

A committee composed of Messrs. F. L. Guthrie, J. D. Fultz and S. A. Winter-ton, was appointed to make estimate of damages to Locust Land plantation, by opening of the road recently laid out through said place.

On motion it was ordered that in the event of application or applications for liquor license or licenses, to do business at other points in the parish than in the incorporated towns, the President and Clerk of this Board are authorized to approve such applications, where same are in legal form.

On motion the following ordinance was adopted:

Be it Resolved, That it shall be unlawful to hunt, kill or have in possession, within the limits of Tensas parish, any deer or wild turkey for a period of one year from the 15th of December, 1912.

Be it further Resolved, That any person found guilty before any competent Court, of hunting, killing or having in possession after having been killed, any deer or wild turkey within the Parish of Tensas during the period of one year from December 15th, 1912, shall be fined not less than Twenty-five Dollars or imprisoned in the parish jail not more than thirty days, or both at the discretion of the Court for each deer or turkey so killed, hunted or possessed. One half of the said fine assessed and collected to go to the informer.

The following bills were allowed and ordered paid:

There being no further business, the Police Jury adjourned sine die.
