The Harbor of Vicksburg.
The Washington special to the New Orleans Picayune of the 1st says:
With regard to the Vicksburg harbor, the Commission says: It is desired that as much as possible of the first appropriation that shall become applicable to that purpose shall be expended upon the initial works of a plan having for its object the gradual reconstruction of the harbor of Vicksburg to or in the direction of its former condition, in such proportion, at least, as shall give a portion of the city a water front at low water stage.

This will be attempted by such works of contraction and deflection, located at suitable points above, as shall ultimately effect a diversion of the main body of the stream to the Vicksburg side and the reversion of the shore line above the city by the usual processes of erosion and caving. An early effect will be to relieve the pressure and therefore to stop the expenditures at Delta point.
If the restoration of a navigable low water front to a portion of the city of Vicksburg at a reasonable cost is practicable, it will require several years for its final consummation in the manner proposed.

The commission renews the recommendations that provision be made by law for an appropriation by the United States, through proceedings in the Federal courts, of land and material needed in the work.

JACKSON, Nov. 3.—Reports indicate that the election passed off quietly in this State, and that an extremely light vote was polled, there being no opposition to the Democratic State ticket, and only in a few counties to the county ticket. There was no incentive to draw the people from their daily vocations. The vote will undoubtedly be the lightest polled for years. In this city which has a registration of one thousand and twenty-one, only 500 were cast. Only a very few negroes voted. A telegram says the Democrats carried Panola county by a large majority. Greenbackers and Republicans voted no State ticket. Heretofore this county has been controlled by Greenbackers and Independents and Republicans. This is Gen. J. B. Chalmer's home.
