**Queen of the Harem.**  
According to the story told by Miss Davis Marlow, formerly of Philadelphia, who has recently returned to this country, she has had many thrilling adventures during the past few years. She was captured by Turkish brigands and sold to a wealthy pasha, who kept her prisoner and made her queen of his harem.  
Miss Marlow, it is alleged, made her escape from her luxurious prison with the aid of one of her fellow prisoners, and, through the good offices of a young Englishman whom she met soon afterward, was enabled to reach Paris. From the French capital she journeyed to Boston, where she is now residing, relates an eastern exchange.


