The Brood Sow at Farrowing

A large number of pigs are lost annually because of lack of proper attention at farrowing time. The farrowing pen should be of only moderate size. Many of our successful hog raisers use a pen not over six by ten feet. A guard rail placed eight inches from the floor and the same distance from the wall will save the lives of a great many pigs that would be crushed without this protection.
