For street improvements there was expended by the city during the last six months of the year \$50,000. The prospects for this season are still more flattering. The city has voted \$65,000 in bonds to be used on her water system. A \$25,000 public school building and a large hospital are also to be erected. One large sawmill, two shingle mills, a box factory and a planing mill will be completed and in operation as rapidly as the work can be accomplished.
