of flour, add it to the soup and continue stirring till it all boils. Let the soup cool a little, then add half a pint of cream, a tablespoonful of minced boiled onion, with pepper and salt to taste. Pour into a very hot soup tureen and serve with fried dice of bread. If milk should be substituted for cream a larger quantity will be needed. Carrot Croquettes.—Take six carrots of fine texture. Put in a saucepan with a piece of butter, a small lump of sugar and as much water as may be needed to make a cupful of sauce. Add some minced parsley, pepper and a teaspoonful of salt. Let simmer uncovered until tender enough to mash fine. Then measure and to each cupful add the yolks of two raw eggs, a little nutmeg, a tablespoonful of butter and salt and pepper, if needed. Mix thoroughly and set away to cool. Then shape in tiny croquettes, dip in beaten egg, roll in fine crumbs and fry in deep hot fat.

The KITCHEN CUPBOARD

SOME DAINTY PATTIES.

SUPPER MENU. Cheese and Olive Sandwiches. Sweetbread Patties. Potato and Celery Salad. Chocolate Cake. Fruit. Tea.

WHEN baking patty shells for creamed fish, vegetables or tartaric line baking tins with puff paste and before placing in the oven fill with cornmeal, packing it down. When baked shake out the meal, which can be used over again, and the shells will be found in perfect shape. Patties are light and make a nice food for warm days. The shells may be filled with any food that you like, cold meat or cold fowl being usually used for this purpose.

Highly Seasoned Filling. Cheese Patties.—Roll out a puff paste, season it with a little grated Parmesan cheese and red pepper, and cut it into rounds. Place on half the rounds a piece of Gruyere cheese, with a small teaspoonful of thick cream in which a little mustard has been rubbed. Cover these rounds with a second round of paste, pinching the edges well together, and bake, serving them very hot.

Sweetbread Patties.—Roll a sweetbread pastry, skin it and chop finely with a little ham. Add one gill of white sauce, the same quantity of cream, a little cayenne, white pepper, salt and nutmeg. Make the mince very hot, flavor it with tarragon vinegar and with it fill the patties, which should be made of the lightest puff paste. Serve very hot on a dainty dolly.

Using Up Cold Meats. Ham Patties.—Chop bits of boiled ham very fine. To this add for one pint of meat one cupful of breadcrumbs, one teaspoonful of white pepper, one saltspoonful of celery, one-half cupful of milk. Mix, fill pattypans lined with puff paste and bake twenty minutes.

Curried Chicken Patties.—Make patties cases with light puff paste and bake them. Have ready the following filling: Mince six ounces of cold fowl and mix with it a little chopped ham, some minced sour pickle, a teaspoonful of curry paste, seasoning of cayenne pepper and lemon juice. Mix all together with a thickened rich brown gravy and make hot. After the patty cases are filled scatter a little grated cheese over and just brown in the oven before putting the small pastry rounds for the top.

CARROT OPPORTUNITIES. THE carrot is one of the most useful vegetables which the housewife has on hand in the spring before fresh garden vegetables are available for cooking. Carrot soup, salad, croquettes and puddings are among the variations available in serving this food.

A Wholesome Soup. Cream of Carrot Soup.—Take four good sized carrots, scrape clean and grate them. Place three pints of flavored white stock in a saucepan and simmer the carrot in it for an hour and a half. Rub together two tablespoonfuls of butter with the same quantity
