ELMA, July 22.—E. L. France, L. I. Wakefield and E. S. Avey were awarded \$9,000 in their suit against the Deep Water Logging Co., of Portland tried in South Bend last week. This suit was for trespass. The logging company was accused of logging timber from land owned by local parties. The trial judge held that the local men had obtained title to the land and timber through tax title, and hence that the logging company was trespassing when they cut the timber under an agreement with a former owner of the land.
