That is what Seattle Should Do in Regard to Its Army Post

The time is now at hand, said Captain Fennell of the local quarter-master's office today, when the people of Seattle, if they want to see a big army post at Fort Lawton, should get in and work for it.

The meeting of all the general officers of the army, which is soon to take place in Washington, D. C., will decide the importance of Fort Lawton as a post. They will determine the army posts that should be discontinued, those to be kept and those which will be strengthened. This action is necessary because of the reorganization of our standing army. If Seattle desires to see a big army post at Lawton it should put the advantages of this post prominently before the conference.

The purpose of the meeting was to inform the general of the needs of the Puget sound posts. Major Ruben has quite recently been in charge of the construction of these forts and left Monday to report on their condition to General Randall.
