### P. J. MURPHY IDENTIFIED BY THE VICTIM OF A HOLD-UP

P. J. Murphy, believed to be one of the three men who held up Henry Anderson at the foot of Washington street June 1, was arrested by Patrolman Cameron and Holland last night. At the city jail Anderson identified Murphy as the thug. On the night of June 1 Anderson walked into a saloon at the foot of Washington street and made the statement that he wanted to go to home. Three men engaged him in conversation and told him that they could fix it for him to go free. They took him out of the saloon and in a dark street snatched his pocket and robbed him of \$22. James and John Kelly were arrested on suspicion soon after and are now in the county jail awaiting trial. Anderson has been held in jail as a witness since the occurrence. Murphy will be charged with robbery. The man arrested last night had just arrived in the city on the steamer Queen.

# "THE POOR YE HAVE WITH YOU ALWAYS"

### COUNTY COMMISSIONERS HAVE MANY REMINDERS OF BIBLICAL QUOTATION—EXPEND \$3500 MONTHLY FOR CHARITY

"For the poor ye have with you always," is a scriptural quotation which the county commissioners never have a chance to forget, even though they employ Poor Commissioners Van Horn to look after their charity work, and bestow the county's bounty wisely and well. It is the monthly bills for food and clothing furnished the widows, orphans and aged men and women that ever remind the commissioners of the deserving poor, and the county's purse is always open to help those who are really deserving of charity. The cost of the food, clothing and fuel given away last month amounted to more than \$206. In winter the demand for clothing and fuel is much greater than at present, and sometimes the bills for such relief amount to much more. The expense of running the county hospital is about \$2300 a month, while money given to charitable institutions and board paid for the children who are county charges usually amounts to \$500 or \$700. The average expenditure for charity each month is \$3000, not counting the salaries of persons employed to assist the county in its good work. Poor Commissioner Van Horn, by long experience has become adept in distinguishing between real and sham poverty and makes short work of disposing of the professional "lame, halt and blind" who flock to his office every day in the week with all sorts of tales of woe. Those persons whose misery and destitution is the real thing are never allowed to go away empty handed. Some of the applications for charity are so ridiculous that Mr. Van Horn and the commissioners, who have keen senses of humor, are kept chuckling most of the time. The other day a girl who would

die of mal-nutrition, as she was not able to earn much and keep house. Mr. Van Horn investigated the case and found that the woman was a widow, but one of the grand variety, and that her divorced husband, who was earning good money, was paying her \$35 a month; also that she was earning considerable money by taking boarders. One of the children was here, it turned out, and the other three had been donated by the neighbors for the occasion. There are many pathetic cases of genuine poverty among the regular pensioners of the county, none of whom receive more than \$1 or \$15 a month in grocery orders. One case of an old lady, who has no relatives to care for her and is too feeble to work, and who weeps with humiliation every time her order is given her.
