

JIM HILL SAYS NEW CANAL IS CERTAINTY


MOST POPULAR THING THE NEWLY RETURNED CANADIAN GOVERNMENT WILL EVER BE CALLED UPON TO DO, HE SAYS IN A STATEMENT

(Jas. J. Hill, president of the Great Northern railroad, who makes the following statement regarding the projected Canadian deep water canal, is probably the best posted and most experienced promoter of commerce in America—Editor.)

BY JAMES J. HILL, President of the Great Northern Railroad. Take the grain business going to

the seaboard from north of St. Louis and as far west as grain grows in the Platte valley, and it would not be difficult to see it leave and seek the sea by way of the St. Lawrence. If the Georgian bay canal is built—as I believe it will be—from Georgian bay to the eastern portion of Lake Huron, up French river, up the Divide to the Ottawa system of lakes, it would involve the construction of 32 miles of canal with a

depth of 20 feet of water on the sill, and 22 in the reaches. Only 32 miles of actual canal to build, and for the remainder of the distance existing waters could be used, with some dredging in the Ottawa river. The distance from Chicago or Duluth to Montreal is, I think, 15 miles shorter than it is to Buffalo, going around the state of Michigan. If they build that canal grain could go from Chicago or from Duluth to deep water at Montreal for 2 cents a bushel. Refrigerator ships

could load direct from the packing houses in Chicago and sail from there, drawing 20 feet or 19 feet of water, to any port in the world during the season of open water. The St. Lawrence is open when the lakes are open.

The present Canadian government has just been returned and I think the canal is probably the most popular thing they will ever have to do. For that reason I think there is no doubt of its being built. I know that the people up there are very much taken up with the possibil-

JUMPS OVER THE TRACES

With inconsistency that is characteristic the council Monday night voted to grant a renewal of the license for the Pioneer saloon, Cannon & Willers, proprietors, at 3803 Eighth avenue south, a location which is outside the saloon limits. For reasons that are incomprehensible to most persons, the council has never placed these saloons within the limits, nor even has the matter openly been considered during the years of graft and fighting relating to other saloons outside the limits, where extensions have been made to reach them.
