

MONUMENT IS UNVEILED

STATUE OF MAJ. GEN. McCLELLAN IS GIVEN TO THE PUBLIC AT WASHINGTON—PRESIDENT SPEAKS.

(Scripps Telegraph Service.) WASHINGTON, May 2.—With hundreds of war-scarred veterans and diplomatic military representatives of foreign nations as guests of honor, the government this afternoon unveiled the magnificent equestrian statue of Maj. Gen. McClellan, the great army organizer of the civil war.

The oratory. The president was escorted from the White House by a squad of cavalry.

Gen. H. O. Dwight, president of the Army of the Potomac, through whose efforts the funds were raised and an appropriation secured from congress for the erection of the statue, conducted the unveiling.

The unveiling was preceded by a parade of troops. Mayor McClellan, of New York, the general's son, was present.

HAYWOOD TRIAL WILL BE LONG

(Scripps Telegraph Service.) BOISE, Idaho, May 2.—The men connected with the case say it will take at least one month to get a jury to try Haywood and that the jury when secured will have to spend two to twelve months from their home.

There will be no further postponement. It is admitted that the trial will be a matter of months, at least four. The evidence has cost \$125,000.

BAD BLOW TO DELL'S DEFENSE

(Star Special Service.) BELLINGHAM, May 2.—On the witness stand at Blaine yesterday, N. S. Douglass, a lighthouse tender, testified that eleven months ago he had a conversation with Doan Dell,

charged with the murder of Miss Addie Roper, in which Dell stated that if he ever got his job back again as night watchman he would ruin Miss Roper, and that a match and a little coal oil would cover up a whole lot of things. He also said that he understood Miss Roper carried a large amount of money with her.

The testimony came as a bomb to the defense, which up to that time had apparently little to fear.


