SEATTLE BANKERS WANT ASSET CURRENCY

Authorization by congress of the issuance of an asset currency in lieu of emergency such as the present is the action desired of congress by Seattle bankers. The present emergency has been met by the issuance of clearing house certificates as currency on the authority of the clearing house and general consent of the public. The clearing house certificates are secured by the combined assets of the banks, but in issuing the certificates the bankers are assuming a responsibility which should be shouldered by the government.

WANT FUTURE RELIEF.

The bankers have met the present emergency on their own responsibility, but they will ask congress to relieve them of the necessity of doing so in the future by providing for an emergency asset currency which will be guaranteed by the government as well as by the allied banks.

THE PLAN, FAVORED BY SEATTLE BANKERS IS THAT ADVOCATED BY THE AMERICAN BANKERS ASSOCIATION.

The plan, favored by Seattle bankers is that advocated by the American Bankers Association—the authorization of the issuance of an emergency asset currency to be issued by the banks whenever the currency of the country becomes so contracted as to interfere with business.

TO INSURE THE REDEMPTION OF THIS CURRENCY BY DEPOSIT OF RAILROAD BONDS OR OTHER GOOD SECURITIES.
