CLEVELAND, Ohio, April 16.—The proposed plan to organize a new labor party was being discussed today by a committee of seven, which has been authorized by the United Trades and Labor Council to take charge of the latter body at a meeting of the local on last night, a vote of the locals on the proposed plan to organize a new party showed that 43 favored the project, while nine opposed it. The principal opposition to the movement came from the socialists, who have been planning a new movement in their party.

HEPBURN BILL OBJECTED TO
