

# NEW SUBWAY FRANCHISE FOR FREIGHT SYSTEM

### Agnew Applies for Underground Route in the City.

Underground subway system with carrying tubes to be built directly from the warehouses to the big mercantile firms in the district, is proposed by P. Agnew, president of the city council last night.

Agnew, who leaves for the first of the week, explains that the venture has ample funds and will be completed by January 1, 1914, is the franchise.

Agnew applied for a franchise of 50 years, and the city will receive 10 per cent of the actual cost of freight; 3 per cent of the gross receipts. In 1938, besides an additional 10 per cent of the gross receipts for the rental of the tunnels for conduit purposes, is to be used, and the company will be placed 14 feet below the surface, the company will be responsible for damage to the city.

Work is to be completed after the franchise is granted and any right to route the subway by January 1, 1914, is to be completed.
