

## MAN MURDERED FOR BAD LOVE MAKING

(By United Press.) AUBURN, Cal., Aug. 22.—Jeff Lewis, a rancher, in jail here today following a revolver duel in a saloon at Penryn yesterday, when he killed Ben Swezy, an employe of the Yuba Water company.

Lewis stated today that he killed Swezy only after he had repeatedly warned him to cease paying attention to his daughter.

Swezy was 40 years old and married. Shortly before the shooting Swezy met Lewis in a saloon and said "Let's step aside and talk the matter over."

With that Lewis, it is alleged, drew his revolver and opened fire. He shot five times and every shot lodged in Swezy's body. The second shot killed the man.

Immediately afterward Lewis was arrested.
