On the contrary, like Mrs. Wiggins' little hero, who abhorred a home with a big "H" and who longed in the innermost recesses of his heart for a home where he might fetch wood and carry water for some one who loved him, so Morrison longs, and within his heart burns the fire of independence.

"I want a job," he manfully declared, when he was found by one of the officers of the society night before last at Edmonds, after his last disappearance.

He had begged rides and walked all the way there. Marshall Otto found him wandering the street and turned him over for the night to Mr. Sweet, who had no children, and who volunteered to take him in.

"But, Morrison," said the home officer, reprovingly, "you are too little to work, and no one will want a boy who runs away."
