

UNCLE SAM TO POLICE SEA LANES

(By United Press Leased Wire) WASHINGTON, D. C., May 18.—For the protection of big ocean liners and other craft, Secretary of the Navy Meyer today ordered the scout cruiser Birmingham to cruise around in the Atlantic "lanes" where icebergs have been sighted and to determine the limits of the ice fields. The Birmingham will send in daily reports on the location of the ice. She is now coaling

in Philadelphia and will leave Sunday.

HUMPHREY OPPOSING CANAL TOLL

(By United Press Leased Wire) WASHINGTON, D. C., May 18.—Denouncing the Panama canal bill provisions for imposing tolls on American ships engaged in coastwise trade, Congressman Humphrey of Washington, in the house roundly scored that measure. Humphrey declared that no other nation would give ships flying foreign flags the same privileges as those flying the American flag. He

denied that the remission of tolls on American vessels would be a subsidy, asserting that such action would be to the direct benefit of shippers and an especial blessing to the people of the Pacific coast, who have long been imposed upon by the railroads.
