FAVERSHAM IS
HOT ON TRAIL OF
LIFE AMBITION

A sincere and worthy ambition to become recognized as the leading actor and producer on the English speaking stage is just at present said to be the animating principle and compelling motive of the artistic career of William Faversham, who comes to the Moore tonight in his spectacular production of "Julius Caesar" for three days.

This ambition, this vision of great accomplishment in the field of the essentially literary drama, has abided with Mr. Faversham for more than a decade, or since first he insisted that he be permitted to lay aside forever the cloak and sword of the purely romantic drama.

In deference to his expressed wish he was permitted by his manager at that time to play the leading role in Piner's "Letty," a strong, satirical, biting comment upon certain phases of English life.
