

The greatest naval battle in the world's history is to be fought, now that England has been drawn into the general war. England's fleet is the largest in the world. Germany's fleet is drawn up in two squadrons at either end of the Kiel canal. The eastern squadron is in Kiel bay, an offshoot of the Baltic sea. The other squadron is in the Elbe river near where that stream flows into the North sea. 
