HANSON SPEAK
WILL AGREE ON
NON-PARTISAN
COUNTY TICKET

SPOKANE, Oct. 3.—Five thousand people heard and cheered Ole Hanson, progressive candidate for U. S. senator, at Spokane yesterday.

Wills Hanson talked, a drizzling rain started, but never a person left. He made a speech that will long be remembered.

Intense with sympathy for the cause of social and industrial betterment, Hanson made a comprehensive, clear-cut and constructive plea for state development, urging his plan of farm loans at 4 per cent.

He pleaded for honesty in office and for an honest plot of view. Calling the roll on Senator W. LORIMER, he voted in his defense of crooked senators and judges, Hanson figuratively tacked the hide of the standpat senator on the fence.

"I wouldn't be at all surprised if Hanson's vote in Spokane county, then all the other senatorial candidates together," declared State Chairman Slater.

WITH 2 ROBBERS
NORTH BEND, Oct. 3.—A pistol duel between two men suspected as being the ones who Tuesday night robbed the Commercial store at Redmond, and Marshal George Cobb and Deputy Keener, was fought here last night.
