ed the halls, and there will be fire works aplenty. Brown is taking Gill sharply to task for permitting his civil service board to impose a 50-year rule against city laborers who are otherwise physically able to give good service. He also says that under Gill, nine out of every ten laborers in the city health department's employ are foreigners, and their names are not even found in the city directory. "In spite of this," Brown says, "there are Seattle homeowners, taxpayers and citizens who are denied the right to work for our city."

Griffiths, Picks Mayor's Statements to Pieces in Speeches

TALKS AT RESIDENCES

"I want to be mayor of this city because I believe I can bring about peace and progress here instead of continual strife and petty quarrels." "Thruout my terms in the council, I have stood steadfastly for economy. The records are proof. Mr. Gill is making broad statements. Let him point to the specific things that I—that my vote—can be challenged on. On the other hand, when Gill was in the council, taxes piled up, and they piled up when he's mayor." "Mr. Gill says I voted to put the dam where it is against the advice of experts. That is not the fact. I voted exactly opposite. "Gill loudly proclaims his loyalty to the double platoon system. Since when has he become an advocate of it? When it was before the people, I urged its adoption. Gill remained as silent as an oyster." "Gill says Division A begins nowhere and ends nowhere. True. What has Gill done to remedy the situation? He fought against extending it to Ballard."

These were some of the statements made by Austin E. Griffiths in addresses Monday night. His speech at meetings arranged in the residences of Mrs. L. B. Hood, 1906 N. 44th st.; Mrs. J. M. McClelland, 1009 Seventh ave. N.; Mrs. A. E. Austin, 2218 North 41st st.

"My hope is to put the city on an efficient basis, and I believe, not even Mr. Gill will deny that I have given study and attention to this question," said Griffiths. "I have studied conditions here and have studied them in other cities. "When I decided to enter the race for mayor, Mr. Gill was not a candidate. He said so himself. His so-called tax issue had not arisen then. "My candidacy was not inspired by enmity toward Gill, regardless of the malicious insinuations he is making against me. I served in the council. I served as chief of police. I believe I know something of municipal affairs."

The Right to Work in Seattle

Mayor Hiram C. Gill. You saw fit to butt into the councilman race, and advocated the election of Fitzgerald because you and your friends were fearful that he would be defeated. For this reason I challenged you as well as Fitzgerald to meet me before the people of Ballard and debate the question: "Resolved, That Fitzgerald has not made good to the people, and should not be re-elected." You did not answer my challenge, and I understood that to mean that either yourself or Fitzgerald would meet me. When my announcement bills were presented at your meeting in Ballard last night you made the statement before a large crowd that I was a damn liar and "a damn cheap."

The printer, Mr. Tapendorf, at the Herald office, made an uncalculated mistake and added your name to the front for the day after tomorrow. I will answer you ungentlemanly and uncalculated, but characteristic attack, in my address at the Princess Theatre, in Ballard, tonight, and also in the newspapers tomorrow.

Mr. Fitzgerald or Mayor H. C. Gill. Meet Me Before the People at Princess Theatre, Ballard. Mr. Fitzgerald, you say you have made good, and ask re-election. Mayor H. C. Gill, you ask that Mr. Fitzgerald be re-elected. Is there a reason?

I have engaged the Princess Theatre at Ballard for Tuesday night, and at 8 o'clock sharp I will be ready to debate either Mr. Fitzgerald or Mayor Gill on the question: "Resolved, That Mr. Fitzgerald has not made good to the people, and should not be re-elected." Also I have engaged the upper floor of the Good Eats Cafeteria, at First and Cherry st., for Thursday afternoon at 8 o'clock. At that time I will debate either Mr. Fitzgerald or Mayor Gill on the same question. I trust that either or both of you gentlemen will be there, as your absence will prove that you are fearful of meeting me in debate on this question.

I did not file for the City Council for the mere purpose of getting votes. I filed because there is a great principle at stake in this election. Mayor Hiram C. Gill has compromised me by recognizing that his man Fitzgerald is grasping only the political wreckage he has made for our city and people in the City Council in order to save himself from defeat. So our big Mayor Gill (?) makes a special plea for his little "Fitz" in the real old ward political style. But I will write on this subject tomorrow.

I want to be elected, if I can be elected with the honor to myself and credit to the city that has done so much for me.

SECY. LANSING GIVES OUT TEXT OF GERMANY'S 'LAST WORD' ON 'SUBS'

WASHINGTON, Feb. 29.—Secretary of State Lansing today again directly rebuked Ambassador Von Bernstorff for improper publicity work in the German-American situation. In a formal statement, he declared that morning paper reports of the contents of Germany's latest memorandum had not been made public by himself or by the state department, and that they had not expressed his view on the memorandum.

Morning papers had printed what purported to be a paraphrase of the memorandum. The text of the memorandum given the state department by Ambassador Von Bernstorff was obtained by the United Press today. It follows in part: "The imperial German government reiterates the pledges given Sept. 1 and Oct. 15, 1915, and it does not consider that these assurances have been modified by subsequent events. "Negotiations conducted between the German and American governments over the Lusitania incident have never referred to armed merchantmen. "Furthermore, the formula agreed upon by both governments on Sept. 1 contained the proviso that they should not offer resistance. "The presence of armament aboard merchantmen creates the presumption that they intend to 'offer resistance.' "A submarine commander cannot possibly warn an enemy liner or if the latter has the right to fire on the submarine. It is obvious that such resistance cannot be the meaning of 'armed for defensive purposes,' even if it were universally recognized that defensive armament is permitted by international law. "The imperial German government issued its new orders after having seen, by secret orders of the British admiralty, that the American government about to be used for attack, and that these ships are not merely peaceful traders armed only for defense. "In issuing its new orders, the imperial German government believes it is entirely in accord with the American government, which had expressed similar opinions in proposals it submitted to the entente powers. "The imperial German government welcomes the intention of the American government about a modus vivendi between the belligerents with regard to disarmament of merchantmen, but it cannot see its way clear to change or postpone the new orders because the imperial German government can no longer permit submarines to be subjected to illegal attacks by armed enemy merchantmen. "The memorandum was signed by Ambassador Von Bernstorff, and appended to it was a list of British liners, said to have attacked Austro-German submarines.
