## LYMAN LAMENTS LOST CHANCES

Sorry to Leave Wall Street to Go to Prison Again

### WAS MAKING FORTUNE

NEW YORK, March 2.—The only lament uttered today by J. Grant Lyman, formerly of Los Angeles, now under indictment for mail frauds, was that he had not been allowed to continue just a little longer in operating his Wall St. business.

"If they had let me run my 'Putnam' firm a little longer," he said, after spending a night in the Tombs, following his return from Florida, where he was arrested aboard a yacht, "I could have cleaned up \$1,000,000. I'd be willing to risk a life sentence for that."

As to the operations which resulted in a federal indictment against him, Lyman declared: "I did not get my money from any boss! I sheared the wise ones. I had a million once, but it got away and I started getting it crooked."

He explained he had quit New York hurriedly because he was trailed by a bondsman who had offered collateral in another case against him in Los Angeles.

## PORTUGAL NEXT IN WAR LINEUP

AMSTERDAM, March 2—Germany is prepared to declare war upon Portugal immediately in the event of an unsatisfactory reply to the German note demanding release of German ships seized by Portugal, said a Berlin dispatch today.

LISBON, March 2.—Fearful for their safety, 60 leading Germans here have hurriedly left for Spain upon receipt of reports that Germany is about to declare war upon Portugal.

The majority of German business houses have been closed. Portugal's answer to Germany's demand for release of Teuton ships seized by Portugal was dispatched last night. It is rumored to be a refusal to comply.

## KAISER LEAVES BATTLE SCENE

LONDON, March 2—Freshened by a respite, the Germans are bombarding anew the Verdun and Champagne districts, according to Paris reports today.

This may be the signal for a further German effort to level the Verdun fortress, or it may mean that the Teutons are merely trying to shield troops being transferred to other sectors.

The general view here is that the 26-hour lull in the infantry fighting is preliminary to a grand assault upon the Verdun forts.

Rotterdam dispatches today declared that the kaiser had left Verdun Tuesday and returned to Germany.

This may indicate either that he is satisfied as to the future or is personally quitting the Verdun district because of an abandonment of plans for continuing the struggle.

Geneva reports said several commanders are opposed to continuation of the Verdun effort, and that the Duke of Wurtemberg has supplanted the crown prince in the direction of affairs on the Western front.

## POLICE INTERFERE IN HOCKEY FIGHTS

MONTREAL, March 2.—Rowdyism in National Hockey association games reached what may prove its climax in last night's contest between the Toronto and Canadiana, tailenders and leaders, respectively. In the league standing, after a fight in each of the first two periods, Chief Moffatt of the Westmount police, stepped into the goal judge's box and virtually read the riot act. He warned players that fighting must be stopped or his men would go on the ice and make arrests. Canadians won the game, 7 to 3.

## RUSSIAN CRAFT MAY BE THE FIRST VICTIM

LONDON, March 2.—In the sinking of the Russian 2,800-ton steamer Alexander Wentzel yesterday, Germany may have claimed her first victim in her new submarine campaign against armed merchantmen. Dispatches today said 18 of the Wentzel's crew were lost and 11 saved. Reports failed to say positively whether a submarine was responsible for this destruction on the opening day of the campaign.

## BOY HUNTER KILLED

PRINCE GEORGE, March 2.—Stanley Collins, 16, hunting rabbits with his father, poked his gun into a rabbit hole. The gun was accidentally discharged. He died today.
