MRS. SWEZEA AWARDED HOME

Final settlement of the Swezea divorce trial was made Thursday, when Superior Judge Mackintosh entered a decree granting each a divorce and making the property settlement.

In the final hearings the court found that Mrs. Hannah Swezea had been abandoned by her husband, Bert Swezea, and that she had conducted herself properly following the desertion.

The court held that she was "without fault" in the accusations made during the trial, but that she had been technically cruel prior to the desertion.

Mrs. Swezea was awarded the home on Magnolia heights, valued at \$10,000, all of the personal property, the Peerless automobile, and \$100 a month alimony for four years, or the flat settlement of \$4,000. Calvin Hall, attorney for Mrs. Swezea, was awarded \$500 attorney fee.

The trial of the divorce extended over a period of several days and was bitterly contested thruout.

YOUTH TELLS WHY HE TOOK UP BANDITRY

Most fathers would like their 17-year-old sons to look like Harold Sproule—ruddy-faced, smiling, with bold, good-natured eyes, well-set frame and a knack of dressing neatly and carefully.

But they wouldn't want their sons going around masked, bandit style, and holding up scared women, and then falling into the hands of police officers.

That's what has happened to this boy.

He sat with his face in his hands, in solitary confinement, in the city jail, Thursday. Already he has confessed to Capt. of Detectives Tennant about how he went out with a water pistol and got money by playing bandit.

"I Wanted Money"

"I wanted money," he said to a Star reporter. "And I told each woman I held up that I'd pay her back when I caught up with myself."

Then young Sproule would take the coin to purchase a new pair of silk socks, buy a pair of cloth-topped shoes, a silk shirt or "shoot a little pool with the boys."

He had no protecting home life. Instead he lived in a hotel, and had friends even among the exclusive crowds of young university men.

His parents weren't in Seattle. "I worked on the docks some days during the strike," he said. "When I got a little money I'd spend it."

Stylishly Dressed

He wore a smart, English cut suit and his hair was carefully brushed.

Tuesday evening he went out to the University district, where there are many other young fellows who look like him. He held up a drug store with his ugly-looking water gun, and went back to his hotel with the ill-gotten money.

While in bed, burly police officers woke him up. He was hurried to police headquarters and later confessed.

"Now I'm going to take my medicine," he said Wednesday, "and try to forget what a damn fool kid I've been."

GAFFENE NEAR ACQUITTAL IN MURDER CASE

SAN FRANCISCO, Oct. 19.—James Gaffene, alleged to be Pietro Tortoroli, slayer of Blaggio Villardo, may be free before night. Shortly before noon a jury in Judge Griffin's court was reported to have stood 11 to 1 for acquittal. This is Gaffene's second trial in the last three months. The first jury disagreed.

Gaffene offered an alibi and pleaded mistaken identity. Villardo was slain and his body hacked to pieces 10 years ago in a Green street house. After a decade's search thruout the world, Gaffene was arrested at Seattle.

Cedar River Pipe Line Facts No. 2

Pipe Line No. 1 of all steel would have cost \$1,034,262.00.

Pipe Line No. 1 of wood stave steel-banded pipe cost \$322,952.21.

This saving of \$711,309.79 at 5 per cent interest, compounded annually, would earn enough every eight years (leaving the principal intact) to completely replace the wood stave pipe line, including all the items at original cost.

A wood stave pipe line will give you the same service as a steel pipe line. Its cost is less than half that of steel; the money expended for it will be circulated in this city and will be consumed largely for local labor.
