NAVAL MILITIA OF NORTHWEST MOBILIZE HERE

Flocking to Seattle by boat and by train, naval militiamen and naval reserves of the Northwest are headed toward the Puget Sound navy yard today...

By 6 p. m. the naval militia companies from Hoquiam, Aberdeen, Tacoma and Everett will have reached Seattle under full equipment...

Men assembled at their armories throughout the night, and were still answering the call this morning. Press reports, telling that the naval militiamen had been called, reached Seattle late Friday morning...

They are former navy men who served one or more enlistments, and voluntarily enrolled for wartime duties when they left the service. These reserves will assemble at Bremerton from points throughout the district...

Most of them will be broken in aboard the reserve light vessels at Bremerton, thus releasing the regular jacksies there for duty with the first line battle fleets.

AUSTRIA AND U. S. ARE NEAR FINAL BREAK

LONDON, April 7.—Austria-Hungary apparently has broken relations with the United States.

That Foreign Minister Czernin had instructed Ambassador Tarnowski at Washington to demand his passports was reported from two sources here today.

Information contained in dispatches from The Hague asserted that American Ambassador Penfield and his staff had been formally given passports, and that the Netherlands government would probably represent the United States in Austria-Hungary.

Count Tarnowski has never been formally recognized as ambassador to the U. S. He is now in Washington and has been there for a month or more, cooling his heels and waiting for the United States to receive him formally as a diplomatic envoy.

Tarnowski succeeded Count Dumba, whose recall was asked by the U. S. because of his propaganda activities.
