**DIVES 6,000 FEET MINUS 1 WING**

American Aviator in France Saves Life by Almost Impossible Feat

A. Courtney Campbell, Jr., of Kentworth, Ill., member of the Lafayette Squadron, on July 7 descended from an altitude of 6,000 feet "somewhere in France," with one wing of his machine gone, a feat hitherto unprecedented and always before considered impossible.

Campbell was making a reconnaissance at 4 o'clock in the morning when his lower left wing suddenly broke off and began beating violently against the tail in a manner to leave practically no chance of escape. Without losing his head, Campbell first headed his machine nose downward for a few hundred feet until the violence of the fall finally tore off the flapping wing, thus saving his rudder and steering control.

He then righted the machine, and, by throwing his entire weight onto the right wing in order to overcome the tendency of the wingless left side to fall more rapidly, succeeded in bringing his machine safely to earth a few miles from the La Fayette aviation camp. Entirely undaunted, Campbell was back in the air the same day on a new machine.







Lord Grey was born November 25, 1851, and is of no relation to Viscount Grey, former secretary of state for foreign affairs. He was administrator of Rhodesia and director of the British South Africa company prior to becoming governor general of Canada in 1914.
