GERMAN GUILT IN WAR SHOWN BY BAVARIAN

WASHINGTON, Nov. 26.—Official exposes showing Germany's guilt in continuing with Austria to start the war are being made by Bavarian officials, diplomatic advice here today revealed.

Germany approved the ultimatum of Austria-Hungary before it was sent to Serbia, in 1915, according to combative statements published with official sanction in Bavaria.

In a detailed account, the former Bavarian minister to Berlin describes how the Austrian ultimatum which started the war, was held up after consultation between Vienna and Berlin, until President Poincare and Premier Viviana were on the way back from Petrograd.

The Bavarian minister sent his government a summary of the ultimatum, and stated that it was clear Serbia would never accept. But Berlin, he stated, fully approved of Austria making use of the opportunity, even at the risk of complications.

Maj. Gen. Crozier Is Retired After 43 Years' Service
BOSTON, Nov. 26.—The retirement of Maj. Gen. Wm. Crozier, commander of the Department of the Northeast, just announced, comes after 43 years service as an officer in the army.

Gen. Crozier took command of the department of the Northeast, with headquarters here last July, after being chief of the ordnance department at Washington for 14 years.

He served in many campaigns, particularly in the Pekin and the Philippine insurrection.

Gen. Crozier was graduated from West Point in 1875. He will give up active command here December 1, and his retirement will take place January 1, next.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 26.—Maj. Gen. Clarence R. Edwards, who led the 26th New England division, has been assigned to the command of the Northeastern Department at Boston, succeeding Maj. Gen. Crozier, retired. Edwards will take office December 1.
