## DANZIG DISPUTE GROWS SERIOUS

### Trouble May Follow if Allies Move Polish Army

BERLIN, March 30.—(Delayed.)—The Danzig question has become the most important issue in Germany. The government has taken the position that serious trouble may result unless the allies send Gen. Haller's Polish army to Warsaw by some other route than Danzig. Anti-Polish demonstrations have occurred in Berlin, Weimar, Breslau and Danzig.

The old threat of Danzig is reiterated, many conservative leaders declaring that if the government gives in to the allies, a new radical uprising may be precipitated.

The German armistice commission has suggested that the Polish troops land at Stettin, Libau or Konigsberg instead of Danzig. The situation in the latter city is said to be critical owing to the antipathy between the German and Polish residents. The Germans there declared they will resist every effort to make Danzig Polish. Americans returning from Danzig report the Polish element is prepared to revolt and declare the city Polish as soon as Gen. Haller's troops land. Reports from various sources agree it is impossible to assure the powers a quiet passage thru Danzig so long as both elements are at sword's point. The Germans anticipate the trouble will lead to actual warfare with Poland if the Poles attempt to seize the port.

Field Marshal Von Hindenburg has spent the last week personally inspecting the Polish front. His army probably totals 150,000. It is greatly outnumbered by the Poles, but the Germans are believed to be more effective in actual fighting, owing to their superior equipment and greater experience.

## 2,300 SOLDIERS COME IN TODAY

NEWPORT NEWS, Va., April 1.—Bringing more than 2,300 soldiers, the battleships Kansas and Georgia docked today from Brest.

Detachments of the 146th Infantry for Camp Meade, Lee, Gordon and Greene and nine casual officers were aboard the Kansas.

On board the Georgia were detachments of the 112th engineers for Camp Greene, Lee and Bowie; detachments of the 146th Infantry for Camp Beauregard, casuals from North Carolina and California; a casual company scattered and 11 casual officers. Many of the men were members of the Ohio National Guard.

## "APRIL FOOLED" FRIENDS

SAN FRANCISCO, April 1.—Upsetting all plans for a big wedding in Portland, Capt. Thomas E. Markley, U. S. A., and Miss Marguerite Farrar, daughter of a prominent Northern physician, "April fooled" their friends today by telegraphing them news of their marriage here. The wedding was solemnized last night. A romance growing from the soldier receiving the girl's picture before he started overseas preceded the marriage.

## Steps Taken to Check Radicals

WASHINGTON, April 1.—What appears to be an important step in the effort to check the further spread of Bolshevism in Russia, was seen in simultaneous announcements today by the war trade board and the federal reserve board.

Resumption of trade with Poland and Estonia is provided in new war trade board regulations, granting licenses on commodities intended solely for international consumption. Restrictions on foreign exchange transactions with Estonia, Lettland, Lithuania and Poland were removed by the federal board.

## ACCEPT BID FOR BONDS

The highest tender received, the bid of the National City Co. of New York and Seattle, of \$494,158 for \$500,000 worth of newly authorized port of Seattle improvement bonds, was accepted by the port commission in special session Monday.



## EXTEND PLAN OF LIBERTY LEGION

### Conference Will Be Held in Yakima

Ex-service men will meet in conference at Yakima April 25 to formulate initial plans for the organization of a state order of ex-service men.

This is according to preliminary plans discussed at the Monday night meeting of the American Legion of Liberty, at the Soldiers' and Sailors' club, Rusa Simonton, state organizer, was in charge.

The delegates will work under the assumption that the new order is to be one of the most solid in the state, with a view of affiliation with a great national body later, according to Simonton. Three delegates from Spokane, three from Yakima, and one each from Seattle, Everett and Bellingham will attend the first conference, according to plans.

## BARNES HEADS WHEAT BUREAU

PARIS, April 1.—President Wilson today announced appointment of Julius Barnes as head of the organization for handling the 1919 wheat crop under the congressional guarantee. The appointment was made on recommendation of Herbert Hoover. Hoover, it was further announced, will continue as chairman of the

sugar board until all sugar contracts are completed, and as chairman of the food crisis will be passed.
