## C. J. SATHER IS STATE SENATOR

Defeats James Sutton, Democrat, in Tacoma

TACOMA, March 18.—Clarence J. Sather, republican, defeated James Sutton, democrat, by nearly a two-to-one vote in the special election yesterday in the 21st senatorial district to fill the vacancy caused by the death of State Senator Wilburn Fairchild. The vote was 1,236 to 558.

Sather, an American Legion man, announced himself in favor of ratification of the woman's suffrage amendment, relief for the schools, bonuses for former service men, a short session and economy.

## SEEKING JURY TO TRY WOMAN

Is Accused of Murdering Her Husband

SAN LUIS OBISPO, Cal., March 18.—Sheriff Taylor and his deputies on horseback were scouring San Luis Obispo county this morning in quest of 25 men to try the case of Mrs. Myrtle Dean. A venire of 15 jurors was exhausted last evening and the new group was to appear in court at 2 o'clock this afternoon.

Mrs. Dean, cheerful and smiling, is on trial for the murder of her husband, Fred Dean, a former county official. He was slain by a blow on the head as he slept in his home at Paso Robles early last November.

## SAYS STRIKES LAST WAY OUT

Arbitration of Labor Troubles Advocated

BAKERSFIELD, Cal., March 18.—Warren J. Olney, Jr., associate justice of the California supreme court, in an address before the state building trades council convention here, recommended that labor's prerogative—the right to strike—should be resorted to only after all other means of settling disputes have failed.

Justice Olney appealed for voluntary arbitration of labor differences. Frank L. Homan, a delegate from the Arizona State Federation of Labor, urged moral and financial support for witnesses in the Hisebe deportation trials.



AUSTIN, March 18.—Because oil development brought an influx of rough elements, an increase is being sought in the number of Texas Rangers, ranked with the world's most picturesque and effective law enforcers. The legislature may be asked to augment the force of 77 to 100. The body has been small the last 10 years, except for a period during the war, when there were 1,000 special commissions.
