American Version of London Jamboree Planned

Twelve hundred Seattle Boy Scouts will participate this summer with three thousand scouts of the Puget Sound district in an Americanized version of the International Scout Jamboree presented in London last year, according to plans made at a conference of scout executives from several cities, meeting with National Field Executive C. K. Warner in Seattle this week.

The public exhibitions will include pageantry, international contests and demonstrations by hundreds of boys in each event and will be staged in the Washington Stadium and the Tacoma Stadium the week of August 29 to September 2.


