RINGSIDE NOTES ON COUNCIL

CITY COUNCIL MONDAY—

Referred to committee an ordinance appropriating \$5,000 to furnish work for the unemployed in clearing and grubbing streets in the outlying districts.

Ordered the improvement of W. 65th st., from 14th ave. N. W. to 24th ave. N. W.

Referred to the finance and utilities committees an ordinance appropriating \$70,000 to continue work on the Skagit project.

Fixed Monday, April 4, at 10 p. m., as the date for a hearing on the proposal to revoke the employment license of E. F. Carothers and J. E. McCutley, at 206 Occidental ave., this firm being charged with violation of the city ordinance regulating employment bureaus.

Referred to the public safety committee a communication from Jule C. Gordon, 1512 31st ave. S., asking for legislation prohibiting boys from playing baseball within 50 feet of any occupied building.

Received formal notice that unless the city of Seattle takes over its water supply system, the Georgetown water company will be compelled to discontinue service.

Received notice from Councilman John E. Carroll, chairman of the harbor and public grounds committee, that a public hearing will be held before his committee on the proposed plans for the establishment of a farmers' market.

Appropriated \$283,392 for wages and salaries and \$196,750 for materials and supplies for the money railway for April.

1,000 REDS IN GERMANY TAKEN

Police Drive 3,000 Communists From Factory

BERLIN, March 28.—German police today drove 3,000 communists from the big Leuna works, near Eisen, killing a number of reds and taking 1,000 prisoners.

Minister of Safety Severing said the communist "army," which had been drilling behind the factory walls, offered little resistance.

Severing declared the communist uprising had been crushed. Severing said the communists in the Leuna works had nearly 1,000 rifles, but that they made little use of the weapons, surrendering after the first rush of the police, in which a number fell mortally wounded, while many others were slightly injured.

The communists had hoped to operate the plant for themselves, emulating the Italians who occupied factories in Italy last fall.

In Berlin the situation was improved, although guards remained on duty and machine guns were mounted at strategic points.

Tanks rumbled about the city, ready to support the police and soldiers in case of need.

'Moral Gown' Looks Like a Potato Sack

PARIS, April 1.—The "moral gown" for women, invented by a Philadelphia clergyman, and said to be built along the graceful potato sack lines, has roused Paris.

"These crazy Americans are always trying to suppress something," says one newspaper. "But women will always do what they want to do, and, above all, what other people don't want them to do."

Knee-Length Skirts Doomed, She Says

CHICAGO, April 1.—The knee-length or higher skirt is doomed, and the brilliant colors that have lasted for some time are a thing of the past, according to Mrs. Alla Ripley, president of the National Fashion Art league.

Mrs. Ripley asserts that silver gray and pastels will replace brilliant colors.

Cigarettes Sell Cheaply in China

WASHINGTON, April 1.—The Chinese are becoming more and more addicted to the habit of cigarette smoking. Men, women, boys and girls are cigarette smokers.

Cigarettes are sold for as low as five and ten for a cent. Cigarettes of imported American tobacco sell for 4 cents a package of ten.

17 Testify, But Only One Voice Is Heard
