WOMEN PROTEST HANGING BOYS

Start Fight to Change California Law

SAN FRANCISCO, April 1.—With Roy Wolfe, boy murderer, of Yakima, Wash., saved from the noose by a nation-wide campaign, leading club women demanded today of the governor and the legislature that two other 17-year-old boys sentenced to die on the gallows, be saved.

They demand, too, that the California capital punishment law be changed and a new age limit be set. There are many indications that they will win. Simon Ruiz, a Mexican boy who was but 15 at the time the murder he is charged with was committed, is about to hang, unless Gov. Stephens acts in his behalf. Holding the crime by an older man, and that he knew nothing of the American laws and customs, high Mexican government officials and thousands of Californians have attempted to have his sentence commuted.

William Norris, 17, is almost certain to hang, it is said. Norris was charged with shooting J. W. Reeves, a peace officer, near Redding, Cal. A native of Terre Haute, Ind., scores of residents of that city have interested themselves in his case. The youth has claimed that he thought the more than an hour hold-up man when he shot. The prosecution maintained that Norris and another boy were believed to be youthful burglars, and that, facing arrest, they gave battle. They were pursued by a posse into the hills and captured, narrowly escaping lynching at the hands of a mob.

NEW METHOD IN BUILDING FIGHT

St. Paul Labor Goes Into Contracting Business

ST. PAUL, Minn., April 1.—The St. Paul Trades and Labor Assembly is going into the building business. The 6,000 members of 17 St. Paul building trades unions have contracted with their employers running to May 1. In February contractors notified union men that on February 21 there would be a 20 per cent wage cut.

At first labor forces planned to strike. Cooler heads insisted some new defense method was needed. Then came the plan, quickly approved, for labor to go into business for itself. Articles of incorporation soon will be filed by a newly-organized Central Board of Trade. Stock in this company will be sold to unions, and money will thus be raised for initial financing. Supply and material men, friendly to unions, also will be allowed to buy memberships.

Two subsidiary companies will be formed next. One will direct construction work and be in charge of experts and technically trained men. They will purchase materials and supervise building operations. The other corporation will be a building and loan association. The basic idea of the program is to erect buildings at cost. Thus elimination of profits now collected by contractors and getting rid of much of the overhead expense now borne, union men feel they can get the wages and conditions they believe themselves entitled to and still build buildings at 25 per cent cheaper than under present methods.

One of the first big jobs will be construction of the new \$100,000 Labor Temple here. Labor already has awarded this contract to itself. An \$800,000 job has been promised for early spring if equipment and material can be obtained in time. The new organization expects to be able to bid successfully on several big municipal building contracts to be let this summer.
