



MARSHALL ASKS "SIMPLE LIFE"

Pleads for Genuineness in Personal Affairs

Thomas Riley Marshall, vice president of the United States under both Wilson administrations, pleaded for simplicity and genuineness in the personal life of the nation's people in two addresses here Saturday and one Sunday afternoon. He told the King County Democratic club Saturday he was looking for democrats who believe in equal justice to all and no special privilege; he told an audience Saturday night at the First Methodist church that "as long as one man in nine drives an automobile and not one in 300,000 drives a wheelbarrow, we are not going to get back to normalcy," and he said to the Y. M. C. A. Sunday club Sunday afternoon "you can't imprison an ideal or hang a thought. The only way to overcome a thought is to out-think and out-live it."
