

# NEW ALIEN LAND LAW ATTACKED

## Suit Started to Test Validity of Anti-Japanese Measure

For the purpose of testing the validity of the alien land law passed by the last session legislature, a suit to enjoin Attorney General L. L. Thompson from enforcing it will be filed in federal court in Tacoma.

The suit is being prepared by Frank Terrace, White river valley farmer, on the ground that the alien land bill was passed in violation of the treaty between the United States and Japan.

Plaintiffs named in the suit are Terrace, his wife, Elizabeth Terrace, and N. Nakatsuka, Japanese tenant of one of Terrace's farms. Terrace has retained E. H. Guis, speaker of the house during the last session of the legislature, as counsel. Guis led a bitter fight against the alien land bill.

Preliminary hearing on the case will be heard by United States Circuit Judge W. B. Gilbert, of San Francisco, Federal Judge Jeremiah Ketterer, Seattle, and Federal Judge E. E. Cushman, of Tacoma, sitting en banc. Date for the hearing is yet undetermined.

# TAX REDUCERS START ACTION

## Special Committee Probes Cost of Schools

With the organization of a special committee to examine into the school system, the Tax Reduction council, representing 43 civic and fraternal societies, is ready to begin its investigation into the cost of government in Seattle.

The schools were taken up first, because the budget for their maintenance is the first to be made up.

The tax council will hold noon meetings through the week at Wolf's cafeteria for further organization.

Jay Thomas, representing the League of the Cost of Government league, told the Associated Industries at its meeting Monday that serious studies have been made in estimating the rate at which current from the state may be sold when the plant is completed. Thomas asserted that it would be impossible to sell power to the public at one-half cent per kilowatt hour, as has been promised by city engineers.
