BOY IS DIVIDED BETWEEN PAIR

Will Live Alternate Years With Father, Mother

Mrs. Eva Mildred Semple, who claimed her son, Stanley J. Semple, Jr., 8, was kidnaped from San Francisco by his grandmother, Mrs. Mary Rauon, of this city, will go back to California with her boy.

Judge Frater made the decision Tuesday at the conclusion of a legal battle which has been waged for several months between mother and father, who are divorced, for the custody of the child.

But Mrs. Semple's immediate victory is only for a year. On July 15, 1922, the boy will be brought back here to remain until Aug. 1, 1923, under his father's custody, but in the care of Mrs. Rauon. Thus, until he reaches majority, Stanley J. Semple, Jr., will shift his residence year.

Altho Mrs. Semple brought the action to modify the divorce decree in regard to the custody of the child, Judge Frater ordered that costs be paid by the father.

Dispensing of Patronage Is Unpleasant Job

WASHINGTON, June 15.—Attorney General Daugherty is finding the official dispenser of patronage for the administration a dangerous and unpleasant job.

At the meeting of the republican national committee in Washington recently, so many committeemen and others brought in complaints against Daugherty, protesting against his invasion of their patronage rights and the allegedly hard-fisted way in which he has dealt with state and other republican leaders, that it was tacitly decided to go to President Harding with the matter.

It is reported that Daugherty is shortly to be displaced as the official patronage dispenser. It also is said that the president has been considerably embarrassed by the many objections that have been made to him as to Daugherty's methods.

It is understood that the senate group with which the president associated while he was a member of the senate is among Daugherty's critics.


