

In perfect alignment, Venus, Jupiter, Saturn and Mars will then be within swathing distance, figuratively speaking, of Leo, a configuration of four heavenly bodies. On October 31 the phenomena will be visible, says Brocchi, providing, of course, you get up early enough to see it.

Mars appears to have no love for "The Lion," as he moves swiftly in his orbit, after being much closer than the timid Venus and Jupiter. Saturn risks his precious rings long enough to get in line for a moment with the others and then glides swiftly off.

### Judge Hunts Job to Aid Prisoner


