Returned Goods Regulations

Adopted to Guard Your Health

It is the duty of the State Board of Health to use every means within its power to fight the spread of infectious diseases.

One great, possible source of contagion is the merchandise returned to retailers.

As a result the following regulations governing returned goods have been put into effect and every retail merchant in the State of Washington is required to observe them strictly, under penalty:

REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SALE OF INFECTED MERCHANDISE SECTION 14. Whenever any person, firm, corporation or association shall have delivered any merchandise, such as clothing, wearing apparel of any description, hair goods, brushes, rubber goods, blankets, sheets, pillows, mattresses or bedding, books, to any person or persons, firm, corporation, association or institution, no such first mentioned firm, person, corporation or association shall permit such goods, wares or merchandise to be returned, nor shall same be again sold or intermingled with other goods, wares or merchandise, or be sold to another, until such goods, wares or merchandise shall have been first disinfected in accordance with Section 61 (a) of these rules and regulations.

REGULATIONS HAVE POWER OF LAW SECTION 1. The rules and regulations of this Board shall have all the force and effect of law, and any violation of them, or any failure or refusal to comply with any of its provisions, or to obey the lawful order of any state, county or municipal health officer shall constitute an offense, and any person or persons so offending shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished as provided by Section 5, Chapter 33, of the Revised Laws of 1907.
