



## Politicians Say Ford Presidential Timber

 WASHINGTON, Oct. 9.—Henry Ford may not have his eye on the next presidential nomination, but nevertheless efforts are being made to get him to look in that direction. The American Issue, official organ of the Anti-Saloon League of America, in its current issue prints a lead editorial praising Ford to the skies for his recent "Thou shalt not drink" order to his 55,000 employees. There are in Washington political leaders of national influence who are quietly advising Michigan democrats this fall to substitute Ford for former Governor Woodbridge M. Ferris for his nominee for United States senator against Senator Townsend. This, of course, would help to make Ford a presidential factor. Then there's the matter of finance. The democratic bankroll is mighty thin these days. And a recent financial statement from the Ford concern showed it had assets of something like \$382,627,111.77. The figure may not be exact, but it is sufficiently so to show he could, if he would, finance a national campaign all by himself.

## BOTHELL ROAD IS DEDICATED

Bothell boulevard, the final link in the 55-mile paved highway encircling Lake Washington, was formally dedicated Saturday afternoon. County Commissioners Claude C. Ramsay, Lou C. Smith and Thomas Dobson arranged the ceremony, which was participated in by a number of prominent Seattle and Bothell residents. J. C. Gregory was master of ceremonies. Others taking active parts were Lieut. Gov. W. J. Coyle, Frank B. Cooper, Mayor E. J. Brown of Seattle, Mayor C. O. Wilson of Bothell, Alfred H. Lundin, W. P. Ferrigo, Wm. A. Gaines, County Engineer Thomas R. Beeman, H. J. Moha, president of the Bothell Commercial club, and Frank Terrace, president of the Good Roads association. The new boulevard extends from 10th ave. N. E. to the Snohomish county line. It was first named Victory way, but in response to petitions from residents along the route, the county commissioners on October 5 passed a resolution changing the name to Bothell boulevard, in honor of George Bothell, founder of the town of that name.

## FAIR CLOSES IN TRIUMPH

PUYALLUP, Oct. 9.—With more than 30,000 persons passing thru the gates on Sunday, the last day of the 23rd Western Washington fair, the total attendance for the week was brought up to the 150,000 mark. A crowd that filled every seat in the grandstand listened to William Short, president of the Washington State Federation of Labor, who was the principal speaker. Sunday was designated Labor day and Better Babies' day. Short expressed appreciation of the work of W. H. Paulhamus, who made possible a settlement of the differences between organized labor and the fair association. Medals were awarded prize-winning babies at the conclusion of a parade around the race track. Three pens of six chickens tied for first place in the six-day egg-laying contest. Pens owned by E. D. Sanders, S. T. Stoddard and V. E. Smith, all of Puyallup, laid 29 eggs each. Saturday had been advertised as Old Settlers' day, and a wonderful pageant had been promised, in which a party of pioneers was to be attacked by Indians on the plains while they were en route to the Puget sound country. Circumstances prevented the carrying out of the pageant plan this year, but W. H. Paulhamus, president, has other and better plans for the year to come. "You people get together and organize into a permanent Pioneer Fair association," he said, "so we can get at you. We want Old Settlers' day to mean something to the state at this fair. From now on, on Pioneer day, free admission will be given to all pioneers. And we will see that a permanent place is given them to gather."
