DIRECTIONS For Voting on Voting Machine

- 1. Move RED HANDLE at top of MACHINE to the RIGHT as far as it will go and LEAVE IT THERE. 2. To VOTE FOR CANDIDATES, pull down the POINTERS over the names of the CANDIDATES you wish to vote for from this position to this position and LEAVE THEM DOWN. 3. To VOTE ON MEASURES, pull down POINTER over the "FOR" or "AGAINST" of each measure and LEAVE IT DOWN. 4. LEAVING the pointers as you have placed them (DOWN) in the voting position move the RED HANDLE at the top of the MACHINE to the LEFT as far as it will go and you have voted.
