

CONDITIONS—The barometric pres-

 been general from the northern plains

states to the north Atlantic coast, and
 is reported from a few scattered places
 elsewhere, but the amounts are gener-
 ally small. The weather is cool in the
 northwest, with freezing temperature
 in parts of Nevada, Montana, the Dak-
 otas, Minnesota, Alberta and Saskat-
 chewan. Warm weather continues from
 the Ohio valley southward. Fair weath-
 er may be expected to continue in Boise
 and its vicinity tonight and Tuesday,
 with light frost tonight.
