2. The articles entered in competition are to be cooked at home and delivered between 10 a. m. and noon on Saturday, Oct. 19, at the Pinney theater. A contestant can enter as many articles as desired. One dozen doughnuts constitute an entry in those divisions.
3. IT IS ABSOLUTELY REQUIRED THAT EACH ARTICLE SUBMITTED MUST CONTAIN COTTOLENE AS THE ONLY SHORTENING. DOUGHNUTS MUST ALSO BE FRIED IN COTTOLENE. CAKES, SUCH AS ANGEL FOOD, WHICH DO NOT CONTAIN SHORTENING, WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

4. Prize winners must arrange for the delivery of prizes immediately after awards are made.

A number will be assigned to each article entered in competition so that the judges will not know the names of contestants.

The exhibition of cookery will take place at 2 p. m. Saturday. At 2:30 p. m. there will be a special lecture on "Kitchen Conveniences." After that, the cooked articles are to be sold and the proceeds given to the Children's Home.
