


Full Text of Speech By Colonel Roosevelt at Madison Square Garden Wednesday Night

Friends, perhaps once in a generation, perhaps not so often, there comes a chance for the people of a country to play their part wisely and fearlessly in some great battle of the age-long warfare for human rights.

recognize that, as has been true in the past, so it is true now, and ever will be true, the prime factor in each man or woman's success normally is his own character.

not to exercise the power of the government when only by the power of the government can we curb the greed that sits in high places, when only by the exercise of the government can we exalt the lowly and give heart to the humble and the downtrodden.

Our people work hard and faithfully. They do not wish to shirk their work. They must feel pride in the work for the work's sake.

Seven months ago in this city, almost at the beginning of the present campaign, I spoke as follows: "The leader for the time being, whoever he may be, is but an instrument, to be used until broken and then to be cast aside; and if he is worth his salt he will care no more when he is broken than a soldier cares when he is sent where his life is forfeit in order that the victory may be won."

Friends, what I said then I say now. Surely there never was a greater opportunity than ours. Surely there never was a fight better worth making than this. I believe we shall win, but win or lose I am glad beyond measure that I am one of the many who in this fight have stood ready to spend and be spent, pledged to fight while life lasts the great fight for righteousness and for brotherhood and for the welfare of mankind.
