

THREE BIG MODERN GARAGES ARE BEING BUILT AT EMMETT

Gem County Seat Coming to the Front in an Automobile Way—Much Other Building.

Emmett, April 14.—Three big modern garages are now being built in Emmett. Each one will be of fire proof construction.

J. J. McNish, Emmett's well known merchant, is building a brick garage 65x140 feet in area. It is to be completed by the middle of May, and will be occupied by the Emmett Garage & Auto company.

William Womack is building a solid concrete garage, one story high, for the M. & M. Co., dealers in Ford cars. This building will be 50x120 feet in area, and will cost about \$6000.

The third new garage is being built by H. C. Wilson for himself. He has the agency for the Chevrolet and Monroe cars. This garage is being built of cement blocks. It will be 50x120 feet in size and will cost about \$6000.

There is a fourth garage in operation in Emmett. It is the property of the Gem Garage & Auto company, of which C. W. Shave is the proprietor. He has the Buick agency here.

NEW BUILDING BY MASONS.

In addition to these garages there are two modern business blocks already under course of construction here. One of them is being built by the Masonic lodge on the lot east of the Index office.

The other business block is being built by E. H. Holverson, the well known owner of Emmett's cigar store and pool room. This building will be 25x100 feet and two stories high with full basement, and will cost about \$19,000.

The Moose lodge expects to build a two-story building this year on the lot east of the Golden Rule store. Work on this structure is expected to commence in the near future.



RICH GOLD STRIKE IN SINKER TUNNEL MINING PROPERTY

Nampa Men Interested in Project Highly Pleased Over the Showing Made During Past Week.

Nampa, April 14.—Local capitalists, owning the Sinker Creek tunnel mine in Owyhee country, are highly optimistic over a gold find, which was made the past week during the progress of the development work.

On the south drift a distance of 90 feet has already been driven with approximately 200 feet yet to go before the face will be under the historical Golden Chariot pay shoot, which turned out fabulous wealth in the early development of the great mining district.

There is an increasing belief in this city that the development of this mine is destined to make southwestern Idaho one of the wealthiest sections in the entire world. A complete assay office is to be equipped by the company, that it may have an adequate conception of the import of its development.
