

# JONES APPOINTED COMMISSIONER OF LAW ENFORCEMENT

Secretary of State Given Portfolio in New Cabinet and Accepts — Breshears Heads Constabulary.

## BOWERMAN AND HALL HERE

Commissions Issued to Them— Governor Has Still to Name Commissioner of Immigration—Likely Be Man From South Idaho.

Governor Davis announces the appointment of R. O. Jones, present secretary of state, as a member of his cabinet with the portfolio of law enforcement. Secretary of State Jones has accepted the commission and will perform the duties of that cabinet post in connection with the office to which he was elected. The commissions to Guy Bowerman as commissioner of finance and William J. Hall as commissioner of public works were also issued. Both are in the city and during the day held a conference with Governor Davis.

**DUTIES OF COMMISSIONER.** The department of law enforcement has supervision over the fish and game department, the automobile licenses, the enforcement of the occupational tax and the state constabulary. Commissioner Jones announces that Otto M. Jones, appointed as fish and game warden, will remain at the head of that department which, since taking office, he has carefully organized.

**BRESHEARS GETS PLACE.** F. M. Breshears of Caldwell has been offered the post as head of the state constabulary and has accepted. He is

well known in this part of the state and is an ex-sheriff of Canyon county. Secretary of State Jones is now performing in his department the automobile license work and with the addition of one or two more clerks will be able to handle the occupational tax business. The headquarters of the department of law enforcement will be in the secretary of state's office.

Governor Davis at one time had a soldier in mind for this cabinet position but he was unable to hear directly from him and as the position of commissioner of law enforcement had to be filled without further delay he lost no time in taking advantage of the opportunity of securing the services of Secretary of State Jones.

**BOWERMAN MAY BE NAMED.** The post of state purchasing agent for the state is one that is giving the chief executive some little thought. It is considered one of the most important to be filled because the agent will be called upon to spend thousands of dollars in the purchase of supplies. It is said to be possible that Commissioner Bowerman may be designated to fill the position because the duties of purchasing agent will work in with his department. Immediate adjustment of departments at the statehouse will take effect in order to provide room for the new cabinet members. Mr. Hall, who is to be commissioner of public works, went over the ground carefully with Governor Davis
