**Allen Stewart Passes Away This Morning.**

This morning about 7:30 o'clock Allen Stewart, who resides with three children, Misses Sadie and Mr. Thomas, at their home just north of the Bryan school, who has been ill for some time with heart failure had a relapse and died before medical assistance could be summoned.

The deceased was 64 years of age and has been a resident of the city for the past three years, coming to this city from Missouri where he was a prominent farmer and stock raiser. He was born in Kentucky but spent most of his life in Missouri where he is very well and favorably known. He is also well known in the city and is the father of ten children, five girls and five boys. His wife passed away about four years ago before he took up his residence in our city. The children residing in this city are Misses Sadie and Susie Stewart, Mrs. J. M. Willis, Mrs. D. T. Bedell, Thomas Stewart, Russell Stewart, F. S. Stewart. The children of the family absent are Mrs. E. E. Carrier, Twin Falls, Ida., Duncan Stewart.

The funeral procession will leave the Stewart home at 1:30 o'clock tomorrow afternoon and will proceed to the Baptist church where the services will be held, Rev. Davis officiating. At the conclusion of the services, the procession will repair to Forest cemetery where the interment will be made. The numerous friends of the family and the deceased are shocked at his sudden death and extend their sympathy to the children in their bereavement.
