Taxes will be 40 per cent higher in Idaho county this year than they were last year, although our county has not yet been divided and, according to the contentions of the anti-divisionists we cannot see any other reason for the increase. Added to this the state levy is five cents lower than last year and the county levy should have been less rather than more than last year. However, the ways of the county fathers are inscrutable and we know not whether to charge up the increase in the taxes against the war over in Europe or the county division fight expense account. Figure it out for yourself, dear reader, but in the meantime, better forego some of those pleasure trips and contemplated improvements in your home and save the money to pay the extra taxes.

The Coeur d'Alene Press says: Shoshone county has reduced her total state and county tax from \$3 on each \$100 valuation in 1910 to \$1 on each \$100 valuation in 1915. That is a showing of which any county might be proud. It means efficiency and business methods in the transaction of public business. There are evidently business men at the helm in Shoshone.

What a difference in Idaho county! Here our commissioners increased the levy from \$1 on the \$100 in 1914 to \$1.40 on the \$100 in 1915. What's the answer?

No paved streets for Cottonwood. Our citizens who live in other towns where paved streets are plentiful don't want 'em here. If we who live here want paved streets its up to us to pay our share and the other fellow's, too, or move to some place where the streets are already paved.

The one impediment that can prevent the development of any town beyond every other deterrent, is the people who live in it. You live in your town. Your town is what YOU help to make it.

With the county tax rate increased forty per cent over last year's levy and the village levy a third higher, we are all going to feel the need for bigger crops and better prices this fall.

Clyde Farthing dropped in yesterday from Ferdinand and ordered his paper forwarded to Gibson, Mont., for which place he will leave with his family Sunday to take charge of the land purchased there last summer by S. M. Brown. Mr. Farthing will run the place for Mr. Brown on shares.

John Hoene received a carload of eight Ford cars last Saturday and has most of them already disposed of. Two of the cars were purchased by Roy Nail for his trade in Grangeville; one was taken by Dr. Shinnick; one by M. F. Rogers, of Greencreek; one by John Wagner, of Westlake; one by Mr. Webb, of Reubens; one by Mr. Scott, of Ferdinand, and the others have been spoken for. This makes almost three carloads of Fords that have been sold on this prairie this season. And the end is not yet.


