ALEXANDER ADMINISTRATION CLEARLY VINDICATED

Boise, October 18.—The business and economic policies of the Alexander administration have been nowhere more clearly established and vindicated than in the conduct of the educational and other institutions of the state. A greater effort has been made to make politics out of the administration's policies in relation to the educational institutions of the state on the part of the governor's opponent than in any other department of state government.

The records constitute a complete refutation of the charge that these institutions have been caused to suffer because of economic policies of the administration. Without a single exception everyone of these institutions in the state has been able to be conducted during the first year of the administration leaving in the state treasury to the credit of each institution larger balances than each institution had at the close of the preceding administration.

The figures disclosing the financial condition at the end of the first year of the administration are as follows:

The University had a balance at the end of 1913 of \$66,176.81 and at the end of 1915 had a balance to its credit of \$98,654.06.

The Lewiston State Normal at the end of 1913 had \$60,511.90 to its credit, while at the close of 1915, it had a balance of \$66,012.37.

The Albion State Normal at the end of 1913 had a balance of \$42,439.58 to its credit, while at the close of 1915, it had a balance of \$42,454.39.

The Academy of Idaho at the close of 1913 had a balance of \$51,044.56, while at the close of 1915, it had a balance of \$51,359.82.

The Industrial Training school at the close of 1913 had a balance of \$63,771.02 while at the close of 1915, it had a balance of \$66,856.14.

The Orofino Insane Asylum at the close of 1913 had a balance of \$50,945.91.

The Blackfoot Insane Asylum at the close of 1913 had a balance of \$38,459.37 while at the close of 1915, it had a balance of \$60,178.86.

Other institutions have made a like showing. It is clear if these institutions could be maintained the first year of the administration leaving a balance for the conducting of such an institution for the second year of the administration greater than it had during the corresponding period of the previous administration the institution could not have suffered as political opponents, who are eager to renew their raid upon the treasury, attempt to make it appear.

A number of these institutions, notably the Blackfoot Asylum, will have a large surplus to turn back into the state treasury. This institution was confronted with a deficiency indebtedness not reported to the last legislature as required by law and left over by the last administration, amounting to something like \$15,000. This indebtedness has been paid out of the money made available for this institution and it will have not less than \$30,000 to turn back into the state treasury. In addition to this, it has made more improvements and has better clothed and fed its patients than ever before in the history of the institution.


