ERIN, TENNESSEE.

A reporter of this paper went down to Erin last Tuesday morning, and was surprised to find that the little town had improved so much since his last visit.

The new Court House has been finished and is a real handsome and convenient structure that the people of Houston county may well be proud of.

Several churches have been built and some of them are of the latest architectural style. Erin contains a population of some 800 or 1000 inhabitants and is quite a thriving center.

The merchants do a trade in business. Sells Bro's circus exhibited in Erin on the day of the reporters visit, and of course there was an immense crowd in town; the number of people being estimated at about 1,500.

During the past two weeks tobacco has been coming out of Clarksville at a lively rate. So large has been the delivery at the various factories, that wagons have been detained sometimes for a day or so after reaching the city before they could unload, and the work of unloading and receiving has been carried far into the night. Much of the tobacco that has been brought in during the rush, is in a soft or wet condition, and that has brought about a controversy between the sellers and the buyers.
