THE TWO LITERARY SOCIETIES OF THE UNIVERSITY will engage in a public debate on the night of the 19th inst. It is a good subject, and one that opens a fine field for argument on both sides. It is certain that the electoral college has grown to be a widely different institution from what the framers of the constitution intended it should be. A change may some day be found necessary, and the young gentlemen who are now giving the subject their earnest consideration may be among the statesmen of the future on whom the duty of devising a new plan may devolve. The debate will take place in the Cabinet Hall, and the public are invited to attend.

Cremery Meeting Saturday, March 14. I have a letter from Mr. J. M. Brent, stating that on his return he will stop here about March 14th, and decide definitely whether or not we will build a cremery. The stock subscription list has been left in my hands and lacks but a few shares of being completed. I take it for granted that our people will not neglect a matter of so much general interest, and feel sure that there are a number of public spirited gentlemen who have not yet subscribed who will make up the missing stock, and therefore call a meeting of the stock subscribers and all interested farmers at the court-house Saturday, March 14th, when the organization will take place. I say take place, because we are bound to have it—it's a ground hog day.

It is desirable for all farmers who contemplate supplying cream to attend the meeting and learn something about the system, etc. One of the most important features is to ascertain how many cows within 15 to 25 miles of the city can be engaged to supply cream by the first of May. This has been the greatest difficulty in getting stock subscribed; very few people believe that there are cows enough in the county to support a cremery. If 500 cows were assured we could raise capital enough to build a half dozen cremeries. Confident that there are that many, I will request every farmer who reads this and desires to co-operate to report to me by postal card, between now and the meeting, the number of cows he will have on the first of May, and how many he can add to the herd by the first of October, on conditions that the cream is taken at the house at profitable prices. Nothing is binding in this, but prompt attention will greatly facilitate organization.

The City Council. The board of Mayor and Aldermen met in regular session Wednesday night. The Street Committee was ordered to make a culvert at the corner of tenth and Commerce street, opposite the L. & N. depot. To accept the lowest bid for macadamizing the street between the Tobacco exchange and the People's warehouse. To put down a crossing near the residence of R. D. Mosely on Madison street. To put down a plank side walk on Commerce street opposite the property of D. Kincaid. To put down a crossing on Hill street. To put down a plank side walk on Front street from the Elephant warehouse to the Grange warehouse. To advertise for bids for the scraping from the streets.

The assessor's salary was fixed at \$1000. The election of assessor is to be held Wednesday night, March 11th. All persons observing any defects in the street lamps are requested to report the same to the Street Committee.

Mr. Jesse W. Bailey, a prominent citizen of this county, died at his home three miles from the city on the Port Royal pike about noon, Sunday, aged 57 years. The cause of his death was heart disease, and he was taken off, very suddenly. All of the family except his wife had gone to church. Mr. Bailey was sitting before the fire, and died in that position before he could be removed to the bed. He and his family had been for some time convalescing of the fact that he was affected with heart disease, and the death was not altogether unexpected, notwithstanding its suddenness. Mr. Bailey was a member of the Baptist church, and was a man of very industrious and economical habits. He leaves a wife and two children. The remains were interred in the family burying ground at 11 o'clock Tuesday, with services by Rev. A. D. Sears.

Mr. Alex. Outlaw died at his residence on Franklin street in this city, Thursday morning at 4 o'clock, in the 70th year of his age. Mr. Outlaw had long been a citizen of this county, residing near Corbendale. He moved to Clarksville only a few months previous to his death. He was a man very highly respected by all who knew him and was much esteemed in the community where he so long dwelt. The remains were interred near Corbendale Friday morning, with Masonic honors.

The case of Judge John E. Garner, of Robertson county, was decided in the supreme court Monday. This case was instituted in the circuit court of Robertson county and charged Judge Garner with subornation of perjury. The defense demurred and moved that the indictment be quashed. The court sustained the motion and quashed the indictment. The state appealed, and the supreme court affirmed the judgment of the lower court.

The Hopkinsville South Kentuckian of the 1st inst. says: "The farmers are wearing long faces on the crop prospect this year. The wheat crop has been very seriously damaged by the severe winter, and the most discouraging reports of its condition are heard on every hand. But little if any plant land has been burned and every indication points to a backward spring and poor crop year."

Dr. T. E. Clardy died at his residence near Clardy, Ky., Feb. 26, 1885. The South Kentuckian at Hopkinsville says: "Dr. Clardy was one of the best citizens of the county, a good physician, a true gentleman and a pious Christian. He had been in bad health for some time and his death was not unexpected."

Robert Allen, a little son of Mr. Frank Allen of Jackson, while attempting to board the south-bound passenger train on the Illinois Central road for a ride Saturday, lost his footing and fell. The wheels crushed his right foot and ankle necessitating amputation.

Six of the nine leading applicants for the postoffice at Chattanooga have decided to go into caucus and abide by its decision. This choice of the caucus is to receive the support of all. Each applicant will have three representatives in the caucus. It is reported that Col. Neal, congressman-elect, has written a letter to one of the candidates stating that it was a democratic precedent to leave the selection of postmasters in cities of the size and importance of Chattanooga to the senators.

Tribune and Sun: Now that the State does not need so much revenue the Legislature might very properly pay more regard to that provision of the constitution which guarantees justice to the citizen through the courts "without sale, denial or delay." The people will furnish a remedy for the "delay" part of it at the next judicial election, and the legislature should stop the practical sale of it by repealing the State tax on law suits. As the law now stands, it is so unfortunate as to be forced to sue, courts as an unsuccessful defendant he must pay in addition to the other costs a State tax for the privilege of defending himself. If he goes into court voluntarily and loses his suit for any cause, however justifiable he may be in suing, he must pay the State tax. While it is the policy of the State to encourage litigation it is also the duty of the State to provide certain, speedy and cheap means of settling disputes. The pursuits of a citizen's legal rights should not be made a taxable privilege, but it should be an unobstructed constitutional right.

Our distinguished citizen, General W. A. Quarles, is being pushed by his friends for Minister to Mexico, and we are pleased to learn that the chances for his securing the appointment are very flattering. There are several other patriots in various parts of the Union who have expressed their willingness to serve the Government in the same capacity, but we feel certain that none of them can present better claims for the position or are better qualified to fill it than Gen. Quarles.

The General is a born diplomat, He possesses in an eminent degree that suavity of manner and gracefulness of speech which are supposed to become a minister plenipotentiary, and his strength of mind, legal acumen and extensive information in the field of politics and history, well equip him for such an office.

He has been a Democrat for many years, and has done much work in the service of the party. While rewards are being dealt out to the faithful and meritorious, the General should not be neglected; but his appointment can be urged on the higher ground of competency, with the assurance that no one has a better claim.
