

ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

The Same old Force With Two Exceptions is Elected.

[Thursday's Daily.] The Board of Mayor and Aldermen met last night for the purpose of electing officers for the city.

Mayor Ligon called the board to order and declared the election in order. Alderman Hurst said that so many had asked him for support that it would be impossible for him to vote for all of them, and that he would stand by the officers of the old board.

C. H. Bailey Recorder announced himself a candidate for re-election. He got the entire vote of the board and was declared re-elected.

Treasurer—W. F. Beach announced himself a candidate. F. G. Gilbert was also announced. The vote stood Beach 6, Gilbert 2, resulting in the re-election of Mr. Beach.

Attorney—John Stack announced himself re-elected. He was unanimously re-elected.

Marshal—Clay Stacker announced and was re-elected without opposition.

Policemen—The number to be elected was fixed at five as heretofore. Nominations were called for and the following candidates announced themselves: A. C. Stafford, Pat Ginley, G. Holleman, W. M. Rollow, C. C. Collier, J. K. Smith, F. M. Morrison, J. W. Williams, James Welch, J. E. Robertson, J. Murphy, Thos. McCabe, J. W. Stone and Matt Carkuff.

On the first ballot Stafford, Rollow and Ginley received each eight votes and were declared elected, while Collier received six votes and was elected.

On second ballot Holleman received three votes, Robertson three, Williams and Stone each two; no election. Third ballot Holleman four and Robertson four. Mayor Ligon cast the deciding vote for Holleman and the force stands now as heretofore.

Alex Stafford was unanimously elected chief of police. Alderman Smith moved that Holleman and Rollow remain day police.

Bridge Keeper—B. W. Ballentine was re-elected without opposition.

Cemetery Keeper—W. J. Warder, H. A. Rick, George Ellis, R. E. Robinson, James Welch, C. E. Clark and Sam Wilcox offered. Ellis was elected on the tenth ballot.

Assistant Marshal or Market Master—Geary Lynes and Thos. Jackson were the candidates. Lynes elected on first ballot.

COMMITTEES. The Mayor announced his committees as follows: Finance—Smith, Hurst and Beach. Street—Gilbert, Young and Beaumont.

Assessment and Release—Hurst, Smith, Crouch. Sewerage—Beach, Hurst and Gilbert.

Fire—Young, Smith and Crouch. School—Smith, Beach and Young. Police—Crouch, Beaumont and Wake.

Cemetery—Beaumont, Young and Wake. Market House—Wake, Beach and Young. Water and Lights—Hurst, Wake and Gilbert.

Bridge—Beaumont, Crouch and Gilbert. After the election of officers the accounts were approved and ordered paid, and the Board adjourned.

NEARLY SERIOUS. A. R. Gholson and Wife Came Near Being Killed By Gas.

Saturday night, A. R. Gholson and wife retired and forgot to put the top on a base burning stove they have in their room. The room was nearly air-tight, and the gas escaping from the stove soon filled it. When the cook came Sunday morning to get breakfast she found the occupants of the room nearly dead. Mr. Gholson aroused himself, with some effort, enough to tell the negro to go down to Mr. Jno. Neblett's and tell him to come, quick. Mr. Neblett went to the house as soon as possible, and on entering the room found that it was caused from the gas, as stated above. He threw open the doors and windows, and gave the room all the fresh air he could, and Mrs. Gholson soon revived to a certain extent, though Mr. Gholson was harder to arouse. A physician was summoned and worked with him some time before he was relieved of the effects of the deadly gas.

From this it will be seen that the affair came very near resulting in the death of both parties from asphyxia. People should take a lesson from it, and see that there is no chance for escaping gas from a stove to get in its deadly work on sleeping inmates of a room.
