A swine plague, bearing the resemblance, of hog cholera has attacked the hogs of Jessamine county and are destroying nearly all the hogs of that section. 600 hogs have fallen victims to the strange disease in the last six weeks. There has not yet been any remedy discovered to effect its cure.

The Post-office Department has awarded a contract for carrying the mail between Juneau and Circle City, Alaska. The distance is 898 miles, and the contractors are to make four trips between November 1, 1896, and May 31, 1897. They receive \$1, 700 for each trip.

L. C. Anderson, of Bourcouny, has a pumpkin vine that extends nearly across a ten-acre cornfield and contains by actual count 169 pumpkins. The leaves on this remarkable vine are as large as an ordinary parson, and the stem are four feet in length.
